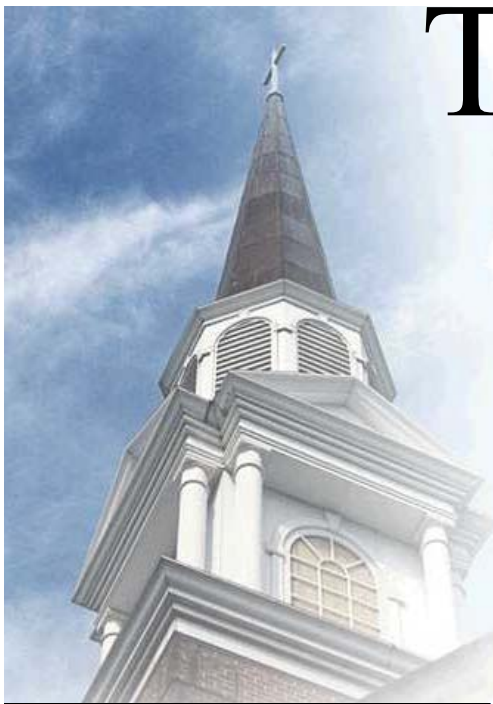

# SHALOM to you...

Welcome to the year of Mark. The lectionary year begins with the first Sunday of Advent, which was November 27th. However, during the Advent/Christmas cycle and on Epiphany Sunday, we depart from Markan readings because there is no record of the birth of our Lord in Mark's gospel. Readings from Mark resume on January 8<sup>th</sup> on the Baptism of Our Lord Sunday. The Sundays following are counted as Sundays "after" the Epiphany or Sundays in "Ordinary" Time.

Epiphany means "to show or make manifest." The biblical stories associated with Epiphany portray the appearance of Jesus as God's chosen one to those around him including the Holy Family, the shepherds, and the magi. The promise of the Christ-child is revealed to them. Today as communities of faith continue to gather around God's chosen one and the sacred stories, the promises of Scripture are still made manifest to us. As we enter Epiphany and journey toward the Transfiguration, we ponder how the Spirit shapes our lives; how we are growing as disciples of Jesus Christ; and how we may even more clearly manifest God's presence and activity to those around us. The Epiphany journey continues as the mirror through which we may actively respond in faith to the needs of our neighbors. We become "manifestations" of God's presence of hope, peace, joy and love as we continue to be transfigured into the image of Christ.

The Christmas/Epiphany story is a reminder that we, too, are part of this journey through which we may reflect, remember those who loved us enough to introduce us to Jesus, God's chosen one, and ultimately give thanks that the gospel came to be born in us. During the season of Epiphany, we will gather around the Word, celebrate the good news and the gifts of bread and wine in community through Holy Communion, and continue to journey toward the transfiguration of our own lives as God's light shines in and through us. In Luke 2:25 Simeon and Anna receive consolation and good news. Along with them, we receive the good word that Jesus frees us to go in peace. God's Word is Incarnate and we have been freed to go out and share the good news with the world.

Thank you for your gracious hospitality and for being servants and vessels who make manifest God's presence, activity, and compassion in the world. The following story is just one example of the difference you make in the lives of others and make it possible for mothers like Ms. C to trust that her children are being cared for as she works to put the pieces of her life back together.

After weeks of contemplating her choices, the Friday before Thanksgiving, Ms. C made the difficult decision to ask Epworth Children's Home to care for her four boys. They had been sleeping in the park, and she was struggling to feed them. As difficult as it was to ask someone else to care for her children, she knew she needed help.

The younger boys, who do not completely understand the situation, have been enjoying all of the Christmas and holiday activities on campus, even though they miss their mother terribly. The oldest is a lot quieter and withdrawn. He, like his mother, silently struggles with the anger and pain of being separated.

Ms. C is appreciative of the support she is receiving from Epworth during this time. She is actively looking for a job, participating in free family therapy sessions offered by Epworth, and visiting the boys on a regular basis.

On a Sunday in December, Ms. C sat with her children in the sanctuary of Epworth Memorial UMC as the younger residents of Epworth performed their annual Christmas pageant, *Silent Night*. After the performance, she joined them in the dining hall for Christmas dinner and they ate together as a family.

Because of YOUR support, Epworth can welcome children at no cost to the parent. Their stay at Epworth is not funded by government dollars, but through the generosity of people like you. Thank you for making it possible for them to be safe, fed, and cared for. Thank you for making it possible for Epworth to be a place through which GOD continues to transform lives.

Thank you for sharing yourselves over these first eighteen months that we have been together as a community of faith. We deeply appreciate your warmth, kindness, and spirit of discipleship and hospitality within and beyond "our" walls. It is an honor and a pleasure to serve as the pastor of Trinity UMC. You are truly blessed and have been and continue to be blessings to us and many, many others!

A blessed and joyous New Year to each of you!

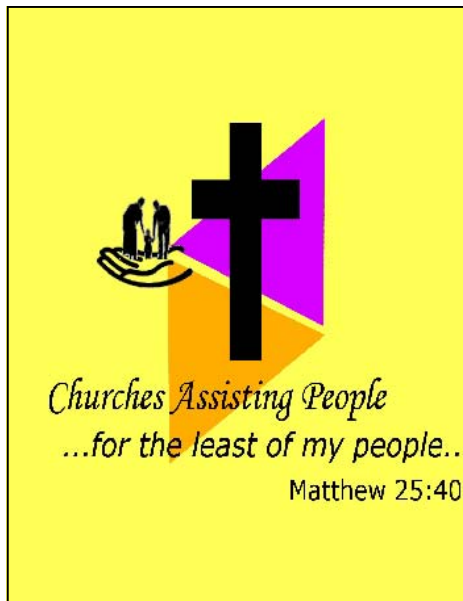

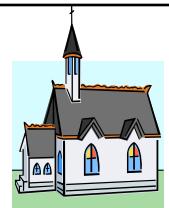
